## Targeted Use of the Catch Up Premium

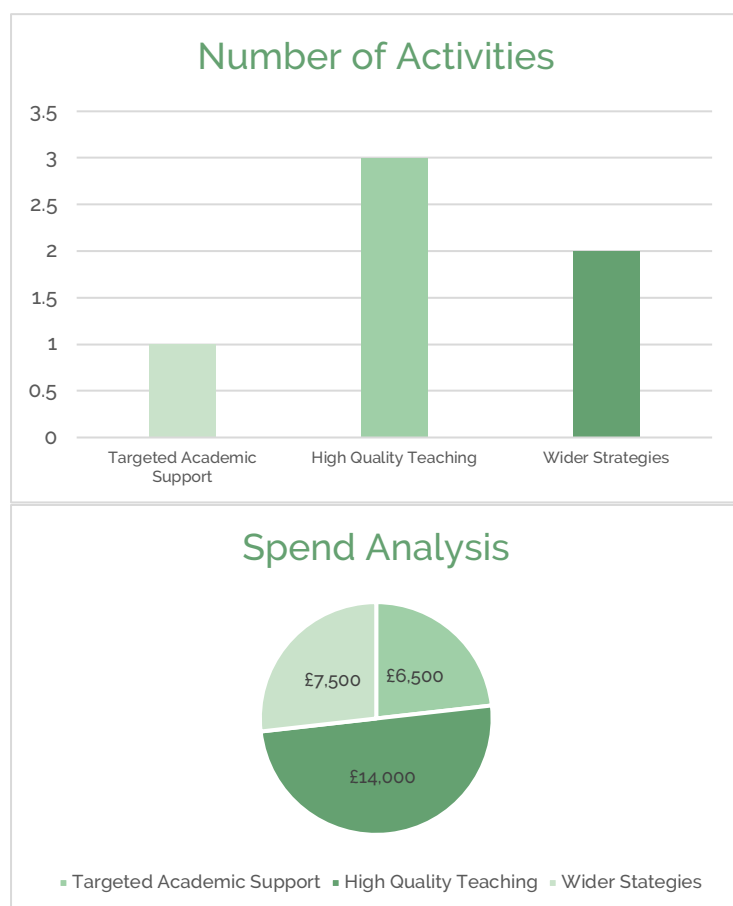
